| 1. What is the allotted performance window after award? | The performance window will be based on water levels due to placing the poles. |
| 2. Plans call out triple 2x12 beam and specs call out triple 2x10 beam. Which takes precedence? | Specifications take precedence plus not sure of the availability of 2X12's. |
| 3. What is the allotment for material lay down and equipment storage area during construction? | The agency is flexible in determining the Contractor's needs. This will not be a problem. |
| 4. What are the requirements if any for fencing off the construction area? | No requirements. The area is gated at night. |
| 5. Is this for replacement of the pier on the southwest corner of the lake? | It is the replacement for the fishing pier that burned down. All that remains is the burnt stubs of the platform poles. Underwater right now. |
| 6. Is demolition and hauling of the existing structure to be included? Is an existing abutment to be used or should a new abutment be included? | Yes, what remains of the existing structure is the responsibility of the Contractor to demolish and remove. A new abutment is going to be built by a separate contractor. The Contractor will be given a top platform elevation to build and the pier will be connected at a future date by a separate contractor. |
| 7. Are engineer stamped drawings to be included in the scope and provided by the builder? | No. |
