1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The State of Tennessee, Department of General Services, State of Tennessee Real Estate Asset Management (STREAM), hereinafter referred to as "the State," has issued this RFI for the purpose of identifying a consultant that has the experience to create a comprehensive real estate master plan for the State's portfolio of real properties. The responses from this RFI will assist the State in the development of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to successfully procure a Real Estate Master Plan Consultant.

2. BACKGROUND:

Tennessee has experienced significant economic and real estate development growth during the past several years, which has led to a real estate market that has become highly competitive throughout the state. The State owns and leases a large number of real properties in the Metropolitan Nashville area and throughout Middle Tennessee. The State seeks the guidance of a highly experienced consultant to create a real estate master plan that will address the long term highest and best use of these properties to include parking alternatives and security issues for government operations.

The State envisions the development of the real estate master plan to be a highly collaborative process between the State, representing the three branches of government, and the consultant. The State will provide real property data pertinent to the development of the real estate master plan.
