The intent of this solicitation is to add to the State of Tennessee's qualified pool of ESCOs. ESCOs who are awarded a contract through this solicitation will become a party to the qualified ESCO pool and thus become eligible to submit qualifications in response to ESPCP project solicitations. ESCOs who are not awarded a contract through this solicitation will not become a party to the qualified ESCO pool and thus will not be eligible to respond to ESPCP project solicitations.
2	We are not licensed in the State of Tennessee yet. Are we required to have a General Contractor License to respond to the RFQ? If so, are there any options and/or exceptions that will allow us to respond to the RFQ (SBC Project No. 529/000-01-2023). 3	The SBC Project No. 529/000-01-2023 (release date 12/19/23) question B.8 asks "Does your company hold an Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract for the 2017 U.S> Department of Energy (DOE) ESPC program?" Please note that the 2023 U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Energy Savings Performance Contract (ESPC), Generation 4 (Gen4) indefinite-delivery, indefinite-quantity (IDIQ) contract list has been released. This contract is the latest IDIQ. https://www.energy.gov/femp/doe-espc-generation-4-gen4-idiq-energy-service-companies. Recommend the solicitation be updated as follows: "Does your company hold an Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract for the 2023 U.S> Department of Energy (DOE) ESPC program?"	The State is aware that the 2023 list has been released. However, to keep the requirements of this second procurement consistent with the requirements of the first procurement, the language was left the same.  Please refer to item #3 below. The State has revised Question B.8 as follows:  "Did or does your company hold an Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract for the 2017 and/or 2023 U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) ESPC program?"

10	From various sections of the RFP it appears that the state agency is not obligated to pay the ESCO for services prior to the Effective Date of the contract. In the event an agency has an ESCO conduct an IGA and then elects to not implement the project, is the ESCO paid for the IGA services?	No. The ESCO will not be paid for any IGA services that do not result in a ESPC project.
11	Does DGS use the same reviewers for every procurement cycle that you issue?	No. Evaluator selection is based on multiple factors including, but not limited to, subject matter knowledge and availability.
12	Will the Q&A for this RFQ be shared with reviewers when scoring so they are updated with particular concerns of the respondents?	The questions and responses associated with this procurement will be made available to the evaluators.
13	In this application (due 1-31-24), are applicants only agreeing to the percentage of utilizing M/WBE+ subcontractors?	The language in the RFQ is simply to evaluate the ESCO's commitment to diversity. The State is looking for the ESCO's to provide an estimated participation percentage should the ESCO be awarded work within the ESPCP. The percentage is in no way binding and should be inclusive of any and all work the ESCO could perform as a result of any contract awarded to them within the ESPCP.
