Every year, World Lung Cancer Day helps raise awareness of the risk factors that may lead to lung cancer, such as smoking cigarettes, cigars, vaping, chewing tobacco and inhaling harmful chemicals such as tar, soot, and radon gas. Lung cancer remains the leading cause of cancer deaths among men and women. Noted below is a few common symptoms of lung cancer such as:
 - o Persistent cough that may worsen over time.
 - Cough that produces blood
 - Hoarseness or wheezing and
 - o Shortness of breath
 - Swelling of lymph nodes
 - Bone pain
