Donna Tidwell	NREMT Report	Mrs. Tidwell went over the fee increase that will go into effect January 1, 2017 for the NREMT testing. The fees will increase be \$10.00 to \$15.00 more. Mrs. Tidwell then went over the June report and reported that there were no paramedic exams during the second quarter. Mrs. Tidwell let the Committee know that she is working with Ann, who is the liaison for the state offices. They are working hard to get the reports that they need. Mrs. Tidwell went over the programs and what sections of the programs that they are having problems with and which programs they are not have problems with. Mrs. Tidwell asked Mr. Roberts to go over what changes they have

Mrs. Tidwell stated that one of their concerns that she has gotten from some of the program directors was NREMT definition of near passing verses passing verses failing. Mrs. Tidwell explained what that meant. Mrs. Tidwell reminded them that this is not the I-85 exam. Mrs. Tidwell let the Committee know that they can go in and sign up for the AEMT assessment exam so they can see what type of questions are being asked. This may be for instructional purposes. If so they need to let Mrs. Tidwell or Nita Jernigan know so they can approve it. Mrs. Tidwell went over the other programs and let the Committee know where we stood in the national standards. Mrs. Tidwell went over if anybody is in the military and enters one of their programs; they enter what they call COOL program. They must be former military and are coming back and they are ready to take the NREMT exam the military will pay for it. They must do their own research to find out how to make application. This is the way the military is helping former military to be able to gain there license. Mrs. Tidwell went over what the military 68 whisky are trained for and as long as Ft. Sam Houston signs off on the Federal Verification they can come in as an EMT-IV. Then they can transition to an AEMT. Mrs. Tidwell did ask that they continue to offer the AEMT transition courses. Mrs. Tidwell stated that in 2016 they will be transitioning to a new portfolio, which should</p>

Mrs. Tidwell then went over what Nita and she came up with for hours. Mrs. Tidwell asked if the Committee thought that this was a feasible request. Mr. Hooker has concerns about cardiac, medical and trauma being lumped together and believes cardiac needs to be alone. Mr. McDiffett agreed with Mr. Hooker. Mrs. Tidwell stated that she does think at some time the hours will have to be revisited. But they have to take it to the Board for approval. Lynn Thompson went over what the Board had wanted and stated that this is a good place to start. Mrs. Tidwell stated that they could request that they ask for all the CEU's when they do the audit, not just the number that they are required to have.
