


PREGNANCY-ASSOCIATED DEATHS **DUE TO SUICIDE** 2017-2020

Pregnancy-associated deaths are deaths that occur during pregnancy or within a year of pregnancy. Each year, many of these are violent deaths (homicide and suicide).








Substance use disorder

TIMING

days post-partum. Most of the maternal suicides (89%) occurred after delivery

RESIDENCE FACTORS



More than **half (56%)** of the suicides were from rural areas of **Tennessee**



Half of the women lived in Middle Tennessee

PREVENTABILITY



of the suicides were determined by the Maternal **Mortality Review** Committee to be preventable

OPPORTUNITIES

- Reduce access to lethal means among persons at risk of suicide; take the free Counselling on Access to Lethal Means (CALM) course
- Participate in Gatekeeper training such as Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR) or the Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST)
- Increase skills in utilizing tele-mental health by participating in training
- Utilize screenings such as the Edinburgh postpartum depression scale
