

Tennessee Update on Measles and MERS-CoV

Brief Description of Event:

The Tennessee Department of Health will provide important updates on measles and Middle East Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus (MERS-CoV) including actions healthcare providers can take to rapidly detect cases and protect healthcare personnel, patients, and visitors. This event will be of particular interest to clinicians evaluating patients, including ED staff, as well as employee health and infection preventionists.
