



Reference Information for Sentinel Provider Network

1. Influenza-like illness (ILI) is defined as fever $> 100\degree F$ (37.8 $\degree C$) plus cough and/or sore throat. Classification of ILI is based upon symptoms only and does not require testing. As of 10/3/2021, CDC removed "in the absence of a known cause (other than influenza)" from the case definition.

Important Information for Sentinel Providers

Sentinel Providers report ILI by the end of Tuesday following the end of the reporting week (https://wwwn.cdc.gov/ilinet/) and collect and ship specimens from ILI cases Monday through Thursday (maximum 10/week per provider). All Sentinel Provider specimens MUST be accompanied by the Order Manifest or Influenza and Respiratory Viral Panel Submission form or testing will not be done. The Respiratory Viral Panel is only validated for nasopharyngeal (NP) specimens. Specimens collected from other sites cannot be tested.

Additional laboratory supplies may be obtained by completing the lab order supply form. To ensure the order is filled, please include the CDC Provider ID Code.
