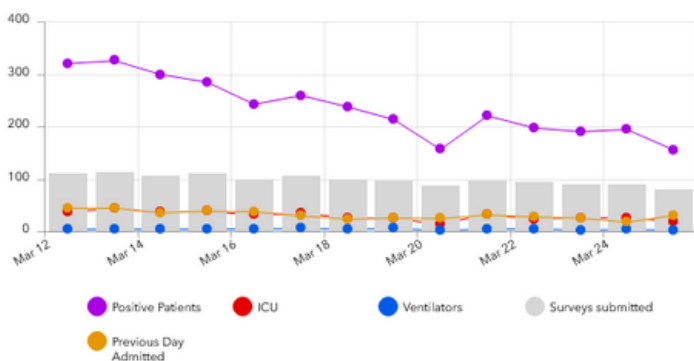

## Technological Stack

### Application:

- Framework: .NET 6 MVC
- Frontend: Bootstrap 3, Razor
- JavaScript Libraries: jQuery, jQuery Data Tables
- Real-Time Communication: SignalR

### Database:

- Management System: SQL Server 2019

### Setup Required:

- Web Host: Required for hosting the application.
- DB Host: Required for hosting the SQL Server database.
- Systems Configurations: Lookup options for state-specific needs within the database.
- Application Configurations: Mainly app-setting changes for customizing the application behavior.

### Setup Recommended:

- Hosting: AWS EC2 for application hosting, AWS RDS SQL Server for database hosting.
- Parameter Store: Utilize AWS Parameter Store for managing environment variables.
- Application Customization: Customize default values such as state settings (e.g., Tennessee) as per specific requirements.
