If positive, please continue to follow the guidance provided <u>here</u>.

Cases: Healthcare providers have 3 options for reporting laboratory confirmed cases:

- Fax the <u>PUI Form</u> and a copy of the positive laboratory report to 615-741-3857
- Call the TDH COVID-19 call center between 8am-4:30pm, 615-741-7247
- Submit an electronic Morbidity Report*

*If you already report diseases or conditions to TDH via Morbidity Reports, you can continue to do this for COVID-19 positive labs. These are electronically submitted to NBS through https://hssi.tn.gov/auth/login.

<u>If negative</u>, and your testing is conducted at any of the laboratories/facilities listed below, there are no additional actions to take. Reporting processes for negative results are already in place between these facilities and TDH.
