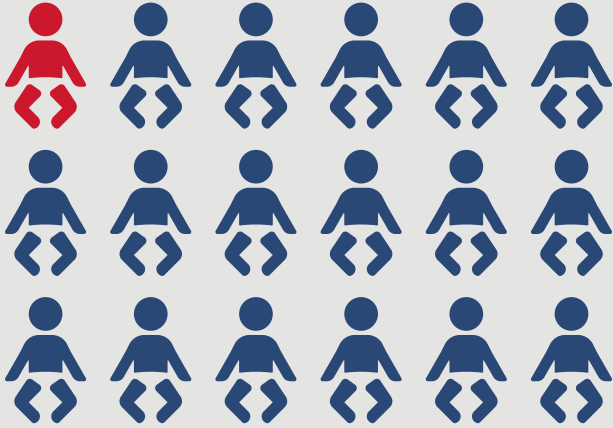


COVID-19 and Pregnancy in Tennessee



Among all infants born to Tennessee residents from March 1, 2020 to October 31, 2021, **7,785 (6%)** had evidence of maternal COVID-19 in pregnancy



ICU admissions at delivery were **6x** as high among women with COVID-19 in pregnancy as those without (**0.6% vs. 0.1%**)



There have been **15 confirmed maternal deaths** due to COVID-19 in pregnancy through October 31, 2021



Among confirmed maternal deaths, **93% (14/15)** had no documentation of COVID-19 vaccination

The CDC recommends COVID-19 vaccination for all people 12 years and older, including those who are pregnant, breastfeeding, trying to get pregnant now, or might become pregnant in the future

- ✓ The COVID-19 vaccine is safe and effective in pregnancy
- ✓ The COVID-19 vaccine is **NOT** associated with decreased fertility
- ✓ The COVID-19 vaccine is **NOT** associated with higher miscarriage rates
- ✓ The COVID-19 vaccine can **NOT** give you COVID-19 or alter your DNA
