TN Department of COVID-19 Health Guidance for Investigations in Healthcare Settings

STEP 0

Implement proactive prevention measures.

Before a confirmed case(s) or suspected/confirmed cluster of COVID-19 is identified in a healthcare setting, facilities can take important steps to proactively protect that patients/residents and staff.

- <u>Review</u> the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Infection Prevention and Control Assessment Tool for Long-term Care Facilities.
- <u>Complete</u> the CDC Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Preparedness Checklist for Nursing Homes and other Long-Term Care Settings to identify key areas that long-term care facilities should consider in their COVID-19 planning.

STEP 1

Notify relevant public health partners of a confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 in a healthcare setting or suspected/confirmed cluster (≥2 cases) of COVID-19 cases in a healthcare setting. If a local/regional health department is first notified, then they should promptly notify The Tennessee

Department of Health (TDH) central office (<u>COVID19.Cluster@tn.gov</u>). Conversely, if TDH central office is first notified, they will promptly notify the respective metro/regional health department via the Notify list.

STEP 2

Perform initial assessment at facility.

• Complete the **Questionnaire for Possible COVID-19 Illness Cluster** to obtain basic facility and patient information.

STEP 3

Identify a metro/regional epidemiology and infection prevention point-of-contact for the cluster.

If HAI infection prevention assistance is needed, notify TDH central office.

STEP 4

Build situation report and communicate information with relevant groups in metro/regional office and central office.

• Review Investigations in Healthcare Settings overview document discussing the approach to infection control/prevention, contact tracing, environmental cleaning and clinical testing when case(s) of COVID-19 are identified among staff/patients/residents of a healthcare facility.

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- Utilize the template Line List template for COVID-19 cases in a Healthcare Facility to systematically track information on suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff/residents/patients in a healthcare facility.
- <u>Share_TDH Healthcare Worker Case Guidance</u> document with information for healthcare workers who may have been exposed to or ill from COVID-19.

STEP 5

Determine public health response based on situation report.

- Consult Investigations in Healthcare Settings overview document.
- Considerations include:
 - Messaging (facility, community and media)
 - o Determine extent of testing needed
 - Coordinate and send specimens to the State Public Health Laboratory
 - Notification of testing results
 - Cohorting of patients within the facility
 - o Environmental cleaning
 - Ongoing infection prevention activities
- Consider <u>repeating</u> the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Infection Prevention and Control Assessment Tool for Long-term Care Facilities.

STEP 6

Continually reassess situation and mitigation activities.
