Pursuant to the Commission's vote at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 19, 2021, each person wishing to approach the Commission with public comment shall:

- (1) Submit written notice which shall be received not less than 10 days prior to the requested meeting date;
- (2) Provide a written summary of the subject matter of the presentation along with any proposed materials for distribution to the Commission in the written notice; and
- (3) Limit speaking comments to the Commission to 10 minutes. The Commission's chairperson, solely, retains discretion to allow a speaker to engage the Commission longer than 10 minutes.
