(1) Submit written notice which shall be received not us than 2 days prior to the requested meeting date;

(2) Provide a written summary of the summary of the presentation along with any proposed materials for distribution to the Commission where written notice; and

(3) Limit speaking commend to the Commission to 10 minutes. The Commission's chairperson, solely, retains discretion to collow a peak to engage the Commission longer than 10 minutes.

(4) The Public comment segment of each meeting has a time restriction of 20 minutes; Commission staff are decigated to allot time based on the number of speakers; all requests to appear for public comment should be made through Commission staff.
