(2) Provide a written summery on the subject matter of the presentation along with any proposed materials for distribution to the Computer in the written notice; and

(3) Limit speaking commonst to commission to 10 minutes. The Commission's chairperson, solely, retains discrete commission longer than 10 minutes.

(4) The rublic Contractor segment of each meeting has a time restriction of 20 minutes; Commission statutine delegated to allot time based on the number of speakers; all requests to appear for public communit should be made through Commission staff.
