\*Pursuant to the Commission's vote at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 19, 2021, with item (4) added via a vote on August 25, 2023, each person wishing to approach the Commission with public comment shall:

(1) Submit written notice which shall be received not less than 10 days prior to the requested meeting date;

(2) Provide a written summary of the subject matter of the presentation along with any proposed materials for distribution to the Commission in the written notice; and

(3) Limit speaking comments to the Commission to 10 minutes. The Commission's chairperson, solely, retains discretion to allow a speaker to engage the Commission longer than 10 minutes.

(4) The Public Comment segment of each meeting has a time restriction of 20 minutes; Commission staff are delegated to allot time based on the number of speakers; all requests to appear for public comment should be made through Commission staff.
