The Board then asked this Task Force to be formed and do the research on it. Mr. Ward stated that there is not anyone who has a problem, it was just asked if we should be regulating them or not. Mr. Mitchell talked about being one of the services that are first on the scene and would like to look at being able to get some of the resources that are available at the state level. They talked about where the funding is coming from and where it is going. Mrs. Tidwell stated that even

There was a question if they are looking at converting all First Responder Non Transport Agency to license or are we looking for an option that they can be licensed if they choose to be. Mrs. Tidwell asked if they could have that option. That was what some of them was looking for, the option to get licensed if they wish. Mr. Hodges stated that they would have to look into an opt in option. Mrs. Tidwell stated that she will have to look into the continuing education and if they can do their own. They had a discussion about in house training for continuing education. Mrs. Tidwell stated that Mr. Hodges will have to look into this and report back to the Board. Mrs. Tidwell stated that there are a lot of things to take into consideration if they move forward with this. Mrs. Tidwell stated that it may go further than just the fire services. Mrs. Tidwell explained the only time when they can regulate the non-transport service, is when there is more than five thousand people at the event. The Committee decided to let Mr. Hodges research and get back to them. Mrs. Tidwell stated that she will send some dates out and get everyone's input for another meeting date.</p>
