Must include at least one Basic EMT or higher-level provider. - Any change in the level of service (ALS/BLS) by a licensed ambulance provider must be immediately reported to the Regional EMS Consultant. - The committee motioned and approved the amended changes to the proposed Ambulance Service Classification Rules. - The approved updates will be presented to the EMS Board on June 16, 2025. | | | |
