

LAPSED LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS
EMT and AEMT

◆ THOSE THAT HAVE AN **EXPIRED** LICENSE AND ARE **WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS** OF THEIR EXPIRATION DATE MUST:

- Submit **proof of continuing education hours *or* passed assessment exam** for your rank taken/obtained ***within renewal cycle***
- Submit completed **renewal invoice or professional fee form**
- Submit appropriate **renewal** fee for license level:
 - EMT =**\$65.00**
 - AEMT =**\$65.00**
- Submit **late** fee of **\$25.00**

◆ THOSE THAT HAVE A LICENSE THAT IS EXPIRED **GREATER THAN SIXTY (60) DAYS** MUST:

- Successfully complete the National Registry **assessment examination** for your rank
- Submit completed **renewal invoice or professional fee form**
- Submit appropriate **renewal** fee for license level:
 - EMT =**\$65.00**
 - AEMT =**\$65.00**
- Submit **reinstatement** fee of **\$100.00**

◆ THOSE THAT HAVE A LICENSE THAT IS EXPIRED **GREATER THAN ONE (1) YEAR** MUST:

- Successfully complete a state approved **refresher course** for your license level
- Successfully complete the National Registry **assessment exam** for your rank
- Successfully complete a **practical examination** for your license level
- Submit completed **renewal invoice or professional fee form**
- Submit a **criminal background check**.
- Submit appropriate **renewal** fee for license level:
 - EMT =**\$65.00**
 - AEMT =**\$65.00**
- Submit **reinstatement** fee of **\$100.00**

◆ THOSE THAT HAVE A LICENSE THAT IS EXPIRED **GREATER THAN TWO (2) YEAR** MUST COMPLETE THE INITIAL COURSE IN ITS ENTIRETY AND APPLY FOR A NEW LICENSE.
