Call to Order

Ms. Earnest called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM CST. A roll call of Board Members and Board staff present was initiated by Ms. Wallace. A quorum of Board Members was present with Mr. Carroll, Ms. Earnest, Mr. Nwobilor, Mr. Parham, and Ms. Smith in attendance.

Administrative Office staff, including Ms. Kimberly Wallace, Ms. Lyndsey Boone, and Ms. Leigha Kullman, were introduced as well as board advisory attorney, Ms. Ashley Fine.

Rulemaking Hearing

Rules Chapter 0470-01

Ms. Fine moderated the rulemaking hearing with the Board. All Board Members confirmed their attendance and participation, including Mr. Carroll, Ms. Earnest, Mr. Nwobilor, Mr. Parham, and Ms. Smith.

The purpose of this rulemaking hearing was to solicit comments on the Board's/Committee's proposal to amend Rules: 0470-01-.01; 0470-01-.02; 0470-01-.03; 0470-01-.04; 0470-01-.05; 0470-01-.06; 0470-01-.07; 0470-01-.08; 0470-01-.09; 0470-01-.10; 0470-01-.11; 0470-01-.13; 0470-01-.14; 0470-01-.15; 0470-01-.16; 0470-01-.17; 0470-01-.18; 0470-01-.19; 0470-01-.20.

Pursuant to T.C.A. § 4-5-204, the following is a summary of the factual information on which the amended rules contained in the notice of rulemaking are based:

2021 Public Chapter 328 required each agency to review each rule in a chapter to determine if the rule should be (1) amended or repealed; (2) be reviewed further; or (3) continue in effect without amendment. As a result of this rule review, the Office of General Counsel presented a redlined version of the rule chapter to this Board on September 12, 2024. The Board walked through each suggested revision and made amendments to rules regarding the following: Definitions, Scope of Practice, Necessity of Licensure, Qualifications for Licensure, Procedures for Licensure, Fees, Application Review, Approval, and Denial, Examinations, Renewal of License, Supervision, Retirement and Reactivation of License, Professional Ethics, Advertising, Disciplinary Actions, Civil Penalties, Informal Settlements, Assessment of Costs, and Subpoenas, Replacement License, Change of Address and/Or Name, Mandatory Release of Client Records, Board Meetings, Officers, Consultants, Records, Declaratory Orders, and Screening Panels, and Consumer Right-To-Know Requirements. Some of these amendments were more substantive than others. Additionally, the Board reviewed its policies and incorporated some of its policies into the rule chapter.

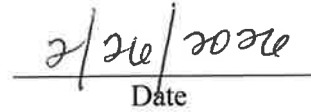
