

Tennessee Board of Dispensing Opticians

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE BOARD'S CONTINUING EDUCATION JURISPRUDENCE CREDIT EXAMINATION

Pursuant to Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 0480-01-.12(1)(a)(1)(i) and (ii) of the General Rules Governing Dispensing Opticians, each licensee shall complete one hour of jurisprudence credit each calendar year by either “successfully completing the Board’s Continuing Education Jurisprudence Credit Examination” or by “attending one morning session of a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.”

For licensees choosing to complete the Board’s Continuing Education Jurisprudence Credit examination, the term “successfully completing” as it appears in Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 0480-01-.12(1)(a)(1)(i), shall mean the licensee answers at least 80% of the questions correctly to receive the jurisprudence credit. The jurisprudence credit shall not be given for the calendar year until a score of 80% has been achieved.

This policy shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
