## POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING GENETIC COUNSELOR – TEMPORARY LICENSE

A temporary genetic counselor license may be issued to an applicant who meets all of the requirements for licensure in T.C.A. 63-6-806 and Rule 0880-13-.04; however, they have not met the examination requirement for certification and do not have current certification as a genetic counselor by the ABGC or the ABMG. A temporary genetic counselor license will be issued for a period of up to one (1) year from the time of the approval of the application by the Medical Consultant.

- 1. Temporary license applicants must have active candidate status conferred by the ABCG and take the next available certification examination.
- 2. A temporary license will not be issued if the applicant has failed the ABGC certification examination more than twice.
- 3. Temporary licensees must practice under the general supervision of a licensed genetic counselor or a licensed physician with a current ABMG certification in clinical genetics.

A temporary license shall expire upon the earliest of one (1) of the following:

- A. Issuance of full licensure
- B. Ninety (90) days after notification of failing the certification exam without obtaining current active candidate status; or
- C. The date printed on the temporary license.
