Applicants who are not citizens of the United States or whose birth certificates reflect that they were not born in the United States shall submit proof of their immigration status demonstrating their right to live and work lawful presence in the United States in accordance with TCA § 4-58-103.

the motion carries. Jones motions to remove number <u>sixteen</u> from the findings of fact, Azimipour seconds, none oppose, the motion carries.

#### Brief intermission taken.

The office of general counsel asks for the board to continue the Randy Vickers case until the board's February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025 meeting due to lack of time. The board agrees.

Newberry motions to accept conclusion of law as written with previous amendments made, Azimipour seconds. None oppose, the motion carries.

Jones motions to suspend the license for 6 months with the conditions that the respondent reports to TNPAP, completes additional hours of ethics and law (core curriculum), and be in a probationary period for four years, to not own an establishment while on probation, and for TNPAP to report to the board quarterly.

Responded is suspended for period of no less than (6) six months, during which time the Respondent must voluntarily submit to TnPap for assessment and monitoring. During this period of suspension, the Respondent will be required to take 25 hours of core curriculum which would include 15 hours of ethics, 5 hours of draping and 5 hours of Tennessee massage law prior to the suspension being lifted. Also, TnPap will report to the Board with their recommendation following their assessment prior to the suspension being lifted. Should TnPap recommend the Respondent is fit to return to practice, after his appearance before this Board at a regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Respondent shall then be placed on PROBATION for a period of no less than four (4) years.
