

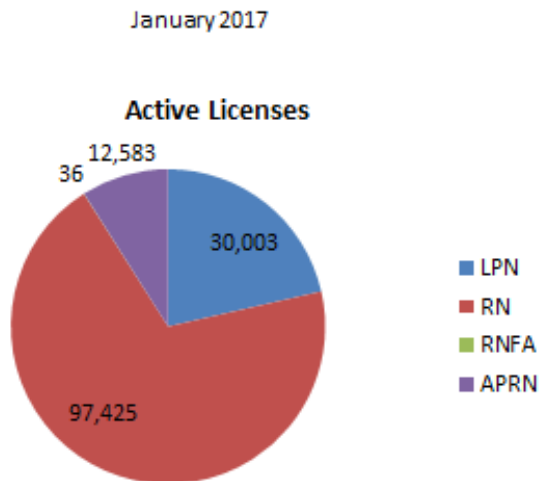
**Tennessee Board of Nursing
Executive Director's Annual Report
February 22, 2017**

1. Licensing
 - a. Partnered with Health Care Facilities to present four presentations statewide to long term care stakeholders on the NLC, e-notify and new legislation
 - b. 50% increase in facilities and licensees enrolled in e-notify
 - c. Added a link to www.nursys.com e-notify to verification page and renewal applications to encourage registration
 - d. ED elected treasurer NLCA
 - e. ED appointed to ENLC Implementation Workgroup
 - f. Developed medication aide rules with input from stakeholders; rulemaking hearing set for May 2017
2. Practice—appropriate, safe practice, curb overprescribing
 - a. Board chair elected chairman of CSMD Committee
 - b. Developed At a Glance Pocket Guide to CPG—posted on web, submitted for publication
 - c. Presentation NCSBN Case Management Conference—Teamwork to Address Opioid Misuse
 - d. Chronic Pain Symposia—presented statewide
 - e. Submitted article *Addressing Overprescribing* to Journal of Nursing Regulation
 - f. Former staff member served on NCSBN Marijuana Regulation Committee
 - g. Quadrupled audits of APRNs for compliance with N&F, certification and CE—obtained 99% compliance with “education to compliance”—No difference in compliance between those randomly audited and those targeted for audits
3. Education—access to data, appropriate standards
 - a. Board’s Education Committee chair Presented on HESI testing—appropriate role of predictive exams
 - b. Electronic annual survey of nursing programs—responded to several states wishing to duplicate Tennessee’s success with the survey
 - c. Workforce data made available via GIS application
 - d. Partnering with Tennessee Action Coalition to provide webinar on GIS and e-Notify March 2017
 - e. Two nurse consultants serve on NCLEX Item Writer Review Committee
 - f. NCSBN Board of Directors upheld the current passing standard for NCLEX-PN® and will remain in effect until March 31, 2020
 - g. NCSBN launched courses “Understanding Substance Use Disorder” and “Nurse Manager Guidelines for Substance Use Disorder” free of charge for all nurses and nursing students. Additionally, five courses for nurses titled “Transition to Practice” is available for a fee of \$40.00 per course of \$150.00 for the package.
 - h. NCSBN using Facebook and Twitter to communicate up-to-date exam policies, registration tips and helpful information and support. There is an opportunity for questions and timely responses directly from their staff.
4. Discipline—evidence-based disciplinary policies fair and consistent

- a. Board adopted Sexual Misconduct Policy
 - b. Board adopted Inappropriate Prescribing Policy
 - c. Board adopted LPN renal dialysis policy, Licensed Practical Nursing Care of Ventilator-Dependent Patients in the Home Health Setting
 - d. Board reviewed, revised and approved all policies
5. Technology—enhance regulation through technology
- a. Applications revised to align with online application—roll out Spring 2017
 - b. Deans and directors video streamed training for transition to online submission of applications planned for March 2017
 - c. Reviewed and updated internet web pages
 - d. Updated online renewal system to enable APRNs renewing licensure to view their supervising physician of record, facilitating compliance by providing a prompt to edit
 - e. Initiated project to enhance GIS workforce data to add satellite programs to school map to give a visual of where schools are located (by type of program—RN (AD, BSN, graduate) and LPN and overlay nurses per county normalized by population using 2010 census data. This will show at a glance nursing education program supply by county. Adding age data to the query as requested by stakeholders.
 - f. Project to transmit APRN data to Nursys separated into phases to expedite. Phase 1 includes a full data dump
 - g. School file imaging project is 100% completed!

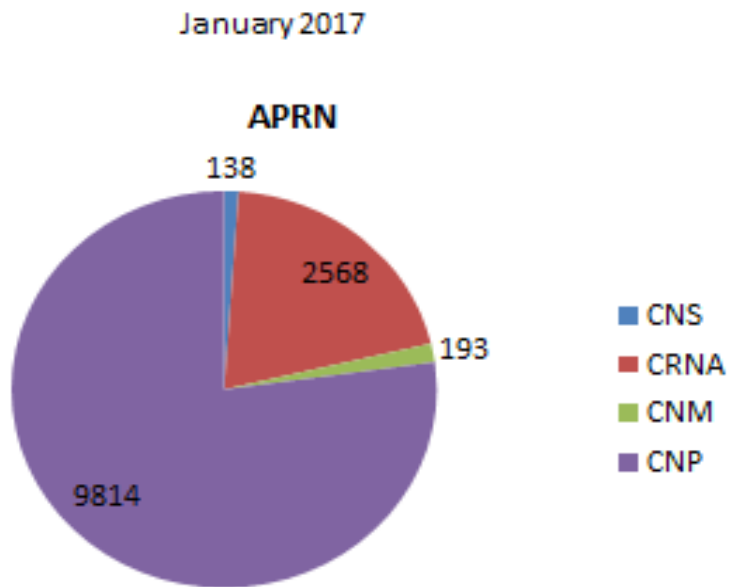

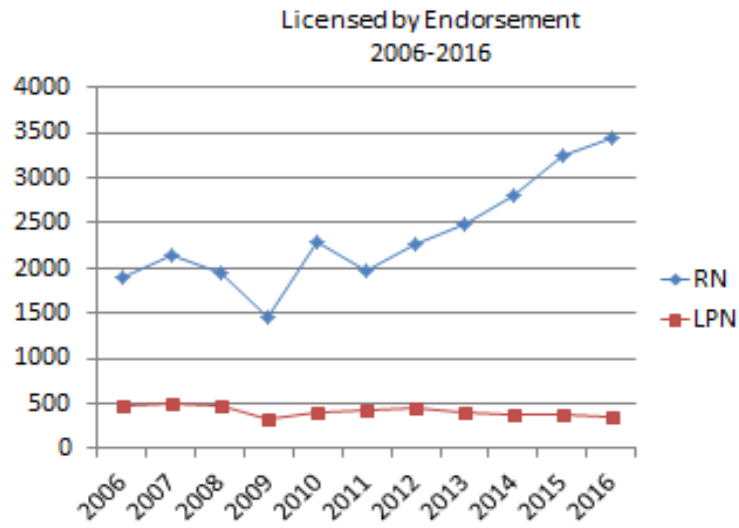

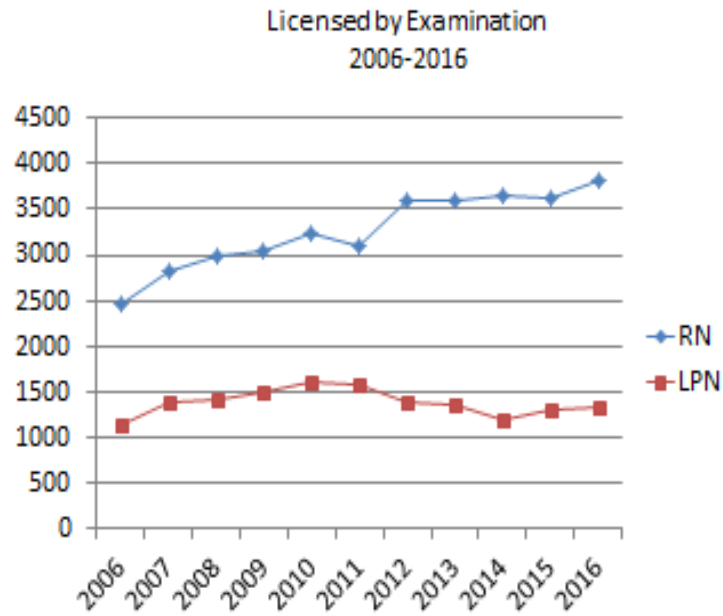

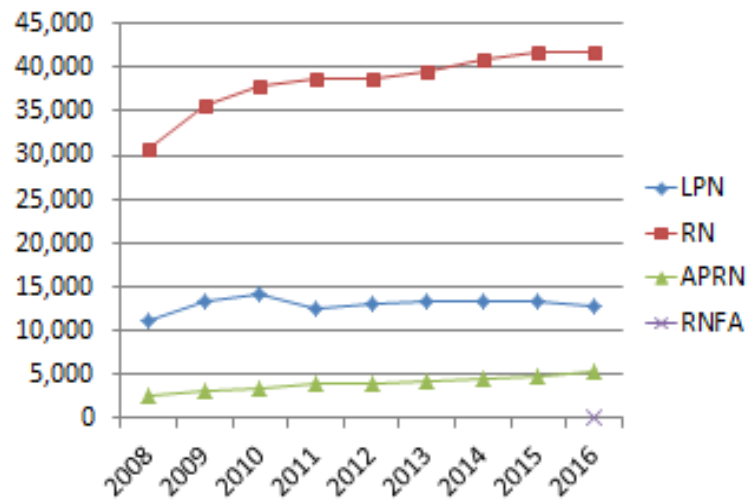


RN=82% increase LPN=23% decrease

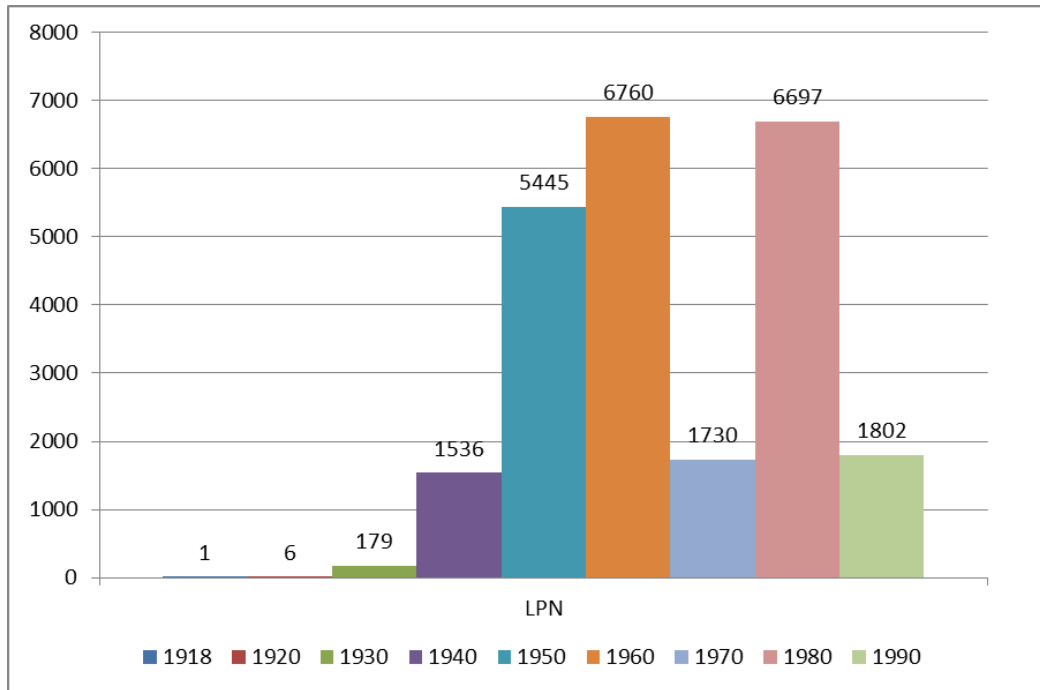

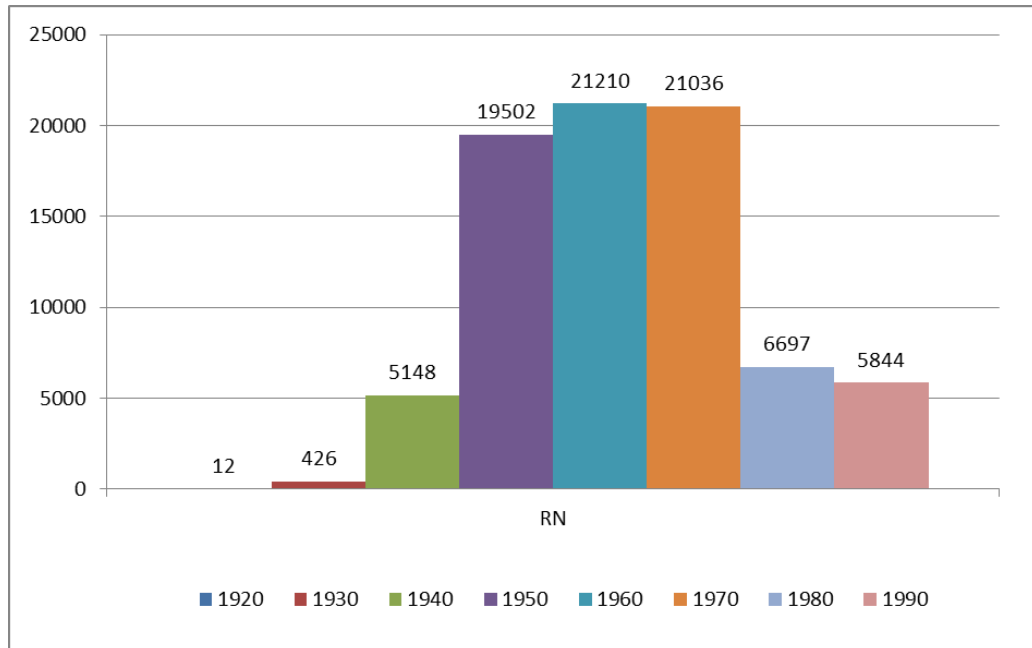

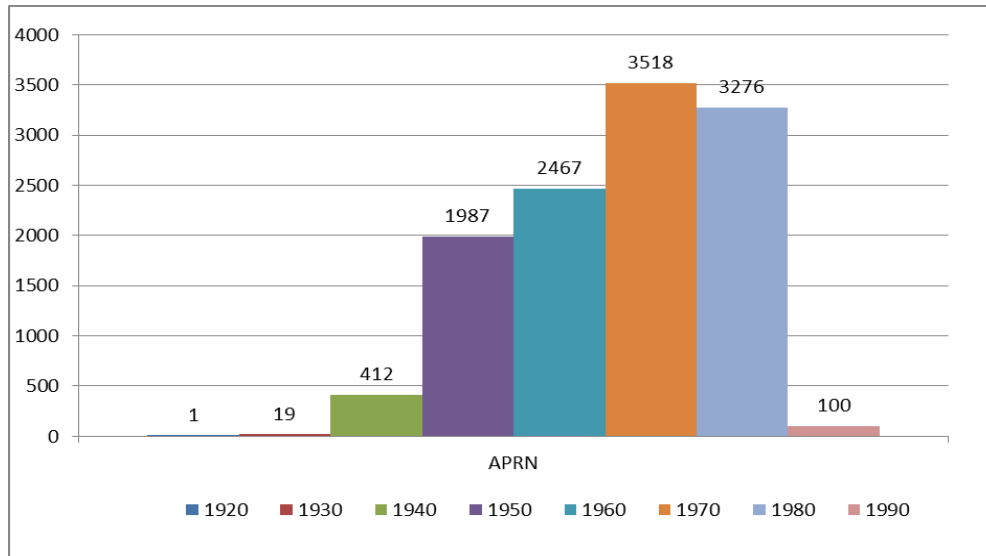
LPN by Decade of Birth
