

BOARD OF OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY
POLICY STATEMENT
REGARDING VALIDITY OF CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK

The board of Occupational Therapy requires that criminal background checks submitted by an applicant for licensure of certification must be no more than one (1) year old from the date of receipt by the Board's administrative office.

When in the case of dual licensure applicants (ex: OT and PT), the Board will accept the criminal background check information submitted to another board if the criminal background check was submitted within the last six months. If older than six months, the applicant would be required to submit a new criminal background check.

This Policy Statement was adopted by the Board of Occupational Therapy on the 9th day of August, 2012.
