Madison County Facts and Figures

140,000

The number of Tennesseans aged 65 and older to be affected by Alzheimer's disease by 2025.

Dementia

Is an umbrella term for loss of memory and other thinking abilities severe enough to interfere with daily life.



Alzheimer's Disease

Is a type of dementia and accounts for 60-80% of all cases.

7th



Leading cause of death for all Tennesseans.

6th

Leading cause of death in the Madison Co.

(Heart disease is the leading cause of death statewide and county level.)

Women



Living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias (ADRD) in Madison Co have a higher mortality rate than men.

(Adults 65+; women 308.2 per 100k vs men 258.2 per 100k)

Whites

Living with ADRD in the Madison Co have a higher mortality rate than African Americans.

(Adults 65+; whites 318.1 per 100k vs African American 209.5 per 100k)

caregiver /'ker.givər/

Provides help to a person to achieve tasks and functions necessary for daily life; those caring for **family members of origin** (mom, dad, brother, sister, grandparent, etc) as well as their **chosen family** (congregation member, neighbor, close friend)

Cost of care provided by 367k unpaid caregivers provided totaling 4.96 million hours.

Caregivers reported having depression.

Caregivers reported at least one chronic condition.

(Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) identifies chronic conditions as heart disease, stroke, arthritis, diabetes, asthma, and cardiovascular disease.)

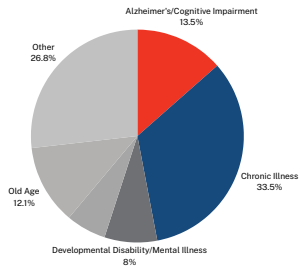

Of all ADRD could be prevented or delayed by addressing potentially modifiable risk factors*.

*Traumatic brain injury, depression, diabetes, hypertension, obesity, smoking, hearing loss, air pollution, education level, alcohol consumption, physical inactivity, and social contact.

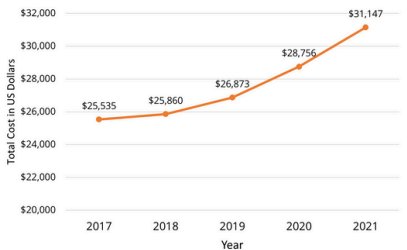

Individuals who visited an emergency department (ED) had a diagnosis of ADRD.

1,531 Visits

Individuals with ADRD experience a higher rate of ED visits, with 1,531 visits per 1,000 person years.

Of all home health claims were from ADRD patients.

Of hospice stays involved patients with ADRD.

(Women living with ADRD stayed 79.0 hospice days on average vs men 58.0 days)
