One day in March 2025, Respondent logged into the telehealth queue and then there was no activity for over 6 hours, causing clients to wait longer times to see a counselor. Respondent was terminated from his employment.
 Action: Reprimand; 15 additional CEs; civil penalties of \$500; pay costs not to exceed \$500.

Licensee: Leigh Anne Goldstine, LPC 589, Knoxville, TN
 Violation: Applicant applied to upgrade her LPC license to an LPC/MHSP on February 20, 2026, after discovering that TDH's licensure verification page listed her as holding only an LPC license without the MHSP designation. She learned of this discrepancy while testifying under oath in court, where she stated that she held an LPC/MHSP license. Applicant appeared before the Board on April 17, 2026, to discuss her application for upgrade. She acknowledged that she had been practicing as an LPC/MHSP since approximately May 6, 2013, when she passed the NCMHCE exam. Applicant also admitted that she did not apply for the upgrade at that time, stating that she assumed passing the exam resulted in an automatic upgrade. Applicant further acknowledged that she had not read the rules and was unaware that a separate upgrade application was required. The Board voted to deny her application. Applicant appeared in front of the Board again on July 17, 2026, to appeal the denial of her upgrade application. Applicant again stated that she had not read the rules and had assumed that passing the NCMHCE exam resulted in an automatic upgrade to LPC/MHSP, after which she began practicing as such. The Board upheld their denial of Applicant's application to upgrade her license from LPC to LPC/MHSP. Applicant violated Tenn. Code Ann. § 63 22 117(a)(1)(C) by practicing as an LPC/MHSP without being duly licensed. Tenn. Code Ann. § 63 22 122(5) defines the scope of MHSP practice. Rule 0450 01-.13(2) states that each applicant and licensee is responsible for being familiar with and adhering to ethical requirements. Tenn. Code Ann. § 63 22 110(b)(3) and (4) identify rule violations and professional misconduct as grounds for discipline.

Failed to comply with a lawful order or duly promulgated rule of the board. Any drug or device that is misbranded, out of date, old, deteriorated, not kept under proper refrigeration as required, or that has been exposed to fire, heat, smoke, water, flood or windstorm damage is deemed to be adulterated, and the possession, sale, or distribution of those drugs or devices is prohibited; and the pharmacy practice site and equipment therein shall be maintained in a clean, sanitary, orderly and well-lighted condition, and all persons working in the pharmacy practice site shall be required to keep themselves and their apparel in a clean and sanitary condition.
 Action: Reprimand. Licensee assessed a civil penalty of \$4,400.

Licensee: Tennessee CVS Pharmacy, LLC dba CVS Pharmacy #2426, Pharmacy Lic. No. 3511, Hixson, TN
 Violation: Licensee, a Pharmacy, failed to maintain clean shelves at the pharmacy practice site.
 Action: Licensee's license has been assessed a Civil Penalty of \$1,000; Licensee must pay the actual and reasonable costs of prosecuting this case (costs not to exceed \$5,000).

Licensee: Tennessee CVS Pharmacy, LLC dba CVS Pharmacy #3293, Pharmacy Lic. No. 3399, Hendersonville, TN
 Violation: Licensee, a Pharmacy, failed to immediately notify the Board's administrative staff of the change in pharmacist-in-charge, for two (2) months.
 Action: Licensee's license has been Reprimanded, Licensee must submit a Corrective Action Plan to the Board, and Licensee has been assessed a Civil Penalty of \$12,000.

- Licensee: Express Med Pharmaceuticals, Inc, Pharmacy Lic. 7663, Monaca, Pennsylvania
 Violation: Licensee failed to have a pharmacist-in-charge for two months; Failed to comply with a lawful order or duly promulgated rule of the board; It shall be the responsibility of the person, partnership, firm, or corporation holding a pharmacy practice site license issued pursuant to T.C.A. § 63-10-306 to notify the board immediately of: The resignation, removal, or death of the pharmacist in charge named in the application for license (or successor pharmacist in charge). The designated pharmacist in charge at a particular pharmacy practice site shall be on duty a minimum of fifty percent (50%) of the hours that the pharmacy is in operation. Except, in any event, the pharmacist in charge shall not be required to be on duty more than an average of forty (40) hours per week.
 Action: Licensee assessed a civil penalty of \$1,000.
- Licensee: Catherine Givens, Pharmacy Technician Lic. No. 45954, Nashville, TN
 Violation: Licensee, a pharmacy technician, while employed and on duty as a pharmacy technician, diverted prescription drug products from the pharmacy practice site. Licensee perpetrated the diversion scheme by removing two (2) cyclobenzaprine tablets from the pharmacy practice site medication carousel then subsequently provided the tablets to a co-worker.
 Action: License is placed on probation for two (2) years. Licensee must pay the actual and reasonable costs of prosecuting this case costs not to exceed \$1,000.
- Licensee: Laura Marie Green, Pharmacist Lic. No. 38977, Maryville, TN
 Violation: Licensee, a pharmacist pleaded guilty to a third offense of Driving Under the Influence, in violation of T.C.A 55-10-40.
 Action: License is suspended. Respondent may undergo an evaluation with the Tennessee Pharmacy Recovery Network ("TPRN") to employ their recommendations. If recommended to sign a TPRN monitoring agreement, the probation of Respondent's license shall run concurrent with the monitoring agreement with TPRN for no more than five (5) years. By following the recommendations, the suspension will be stayed and their licensed place on probation for five (5) years.
- Licensee: Brittany McClendon, Pharmacy Technician Lic. #66239, Evansville
 Violation: Licensee was practicing while her license was expired. Failed to comply with a lawful order or duly promulgated rule of the board. A registered technician shall maintain his or her registration certificate at the pharmacy practice site; additionally, all certified technicians shall display in like manner evidence of certification. Pharmacy technicians shall possess at all times, while on duty, proof of registration and proof of certification, if applicable. (1) All licenses and certificates of registration granted by the Board shall be for a two (2) year period beginning on the date the license is initially granted. All licenses and certificates of registration shall be renewed on or before the last day of the two (2) year license cycle.
 Action: Reprimand; Licensee assessed a civil penalty of \$100.
- Licensee: Zalaya Outlaw, Pharmacy Technician 78712, Knoxville, TN
 Violation: Licensee, a Pharmacy Technician, diverted prescription drug products and cash from the pharmacy practice site while employed and on duty as a pharmacy technician.
 Action: Licensee is suspended. Respondent shall undergo an evaluation with the Tennessee Pharmacy Recovery Network ("TPRN") to employ their recommendations. If recommended to sign a TPRN monitoring agreement, the probation of Respondent's license shall run concurrent with the monitoring agreement with TPRN for no more than five (5) years. By following the recommendations, the suspension will be stayed and their licensed place on probation for five (5) years. If the TPRN evaluation does not recommend

monitoring, Licensee's license shall remain suspended. If thereafter Licensee wishes to have her license reinstated, Licensee must appear, in-person, or remotely, before the Board. The Board reserves the right to recommend reasonable conditions of reinstatement at the time of Licensee's appearance before the Board.

Licensee: Lucy Tester, Pharmacy Tech Applicant, Kingsport, TN
Violation: Criminal Conviction.
Action: Applicant is granted a conditional license, and she shall engage in the Tennessee Pharmacy Recovery Network ("TPRN"), and upon the recommendation of TPRN Respondent shall enter into a monitoring contract. Applicant's failure to maintain compliance with all terms of the TPRN contract, and any amendments thereto, shall constitute a violation of the Conditional License Agreement.
