### **Board of Medical Examiners**

Licensee: Philip Bannor, MD 35052, Smyrna, TN

Violation: In November 20219, Respondent travelled to Ghana, Africa. While in Ghana, Africa, Respondent failed to properly supervise his physician assistant from November 2019 to February 2022. Respondent also abandoned patient records at the practice location for at least a year post practice closure.

Action: Respondent's license was placed on probation for at least three years, and he is required to obtain practice monitoring once employed in Tennessee. Respondent is restricted from supervising/collaborating with students, trainees, advanced practice providers, and pharmacists. He was assessed a \$4,650 civil penalty and costs not to exceed \$5,000.

Licensee: Pelicia Blackmon, AMDX 8036, Cordova, TN

Violation: Worked as a medical x-ray operator for approximately seven (7) months while her license was expired.

Action: Respondent's medical X-Ray Operator license is Reprimanded.

Violation: Failure to provide the patient adequate information about risk/benefits of drug being prescribed; failure to make appropriate individualized diagnosis; failure to document adequate support sufficient to justify the treatment rendered; prescribing without monitoring the patient's CSMD; writing prescriptions under a different entity than the actual patient; failure to monitor treatment of patients by mid-levels.

Action: Reprimand. Must complete two-day medical course entitled Intensive Course in Medical Documentation offered at Case Western Reserve University Continuing Medical Education Program or an equivalent course within 12 months. Cannot collaborate with mid-levels until completion of coursework. Civil Penalty of \$6,000; Costs not to exceed \$1,000.

Licensee: Alissa Hudson, MD 40781, Nolensville, TN

Violation: From November 2020 to January 2025, Respondent wrote at least forty-five (45) prescriptions to herself. She also prescribed medications for her immediate family members. None of the medications were scheduled medicines. Respondent failed to create a medical record for these prescriptions.

Action: The Respondent's license was reprimanded, and she was assessed a \$2,000 civil penalty and costs not to exceed \$3,000.

Licensee: Clyde Mathison, MD 47129, Knoxville, TN

Violation: Respondent was the medical director for an unlicensed medical spa from December 14, 2023, to May 1, 2025.

Action: The Respondent's license was reprimanded. He was assessed an \$800 civil penalty and costs not to exceed \$2,000.

Violation: Violated of a prior board order.  
Action: Respondent's license is Suspended until he provides proof of completion of the ten hours of continuing education in infection control and successfully petitions the board for an order of compliance lifting the suspension of his license.

Violation: Administration of medication without physician authorization and failure to document the reasons for administration in the patient's medical record.  
Action: Revoke multistate privilege to practice in Tennessee.

Violation: While working as an APRN at the Davidson County Downtown Detention Center, Respondent was accused of sexually assaulting an inmate/patient by placing his hand in the inmate/patient's pants and grabbing his genitals. Respondent was placed on leave from his employment and Respondent did not return to his employment at the Davidson County Downtown Detention Center.  
Action: Revocation stayed; Probation not less than 36 months; 25 additional CEs; CPEP Probe; CPEP monitoring before beginning work as an APRN; pay costs not to exceed \$5,000.

Applicant: Lacey Nicole Barber, LPN Applicant, Rocky Top, TN  
Violation: Guilty of unprofessional conduct.  
Action: Applicant's practical nurse license shall be reissued and immediately placed on probation for not less than one year with terms. The multistate privilege, if any, shall be deactivated during probation.

Licensee: Jordan Barnett, RN 245115, White House, TN  
Violation: Improper administration of medication, failure to monitor the patient, failure to properly treat the patient, failure to inform the patient's parents or her supervisor and unprofessional conduct.  
Action: Licensee's Tennessee registered nurse license is revoked; pay civil penalties of \$1,000 within 6 months and costs in the amount of \$500 paid within 12 months.

Licensee: Richard Z. Barnett; APRN #38764, RN #230122, Cumberland Gap, TN  
Violation: In 2025 Respondent was placed on a Kentucky Registry related to abuse or neglect of a child. The placement was related to allegations related to coparenting issues. Respondent remains on the registry for 7 years. In August of 2025, Respondent violated an order of protection. In 2026, Respondent plead guilty to violating the order of protection and sentenced to 2 years unsupervised probation. Respondent was in a TikTok lives group and made a disparaging statement about the patient's he sees as a psych nurse.

Action: ARPN certificate and RN license revoked, revocation stayed; certificate and RN placed on probation for not less than 2 years, complete additional 10 CE hours, complete the EBAS professional standards component; pay civil penalty totaling \$500, pay costs up to \$3,000.

Applicant: Brian M. Baskette, RN Applicant, Memphis, TN

Violation: Is guilty of a crime; is guilty of unprofessional conduct.

Action: If Applicant is in full compliance with the Tennessee Professional Assistance Program (TNPAP) monitoring agreement and passes the NCLEX-RN examination, the registered nurse license shall be issued, suspended, the suspension stayed, and license placed on probation for a minimum of 3 years concurrent with TNPAP monitoring, subject to terms and conditions including reporting requirements and employment restrictions. The multistate privilege will be deactivated until the license is unencumbered and applicant is eligible.

Action: License suspended and upon completion of a Tennessee Professional Assistance Program approved evaluation with a safe to practice recommendation, the suspension will be stayed and the license placed on probation for at least three years with Tennessee Professional Assistance Program monitoring if required and with terms and conditions including reporting requirements and employment restrictions. The multistate privilege will be deactivated until the license is unencumbered.

Violation: Guilty of a crime; Unfit or incompetent by reason of negligence, habits or other cause; and Unprofessional Conduct.

probation for at least 3 years with Tennessee Professional Assistance Program monitoring if required and with terms including reporting requirements, employment restrictions, \$500 in civil penalties, 4 hours of continuing education consisting of 2 hours regarding Conflict Management and 2 hours regarding Professionalism, costs up to \$1,000, and proof of passing the Professional Standards and Unprofessional Conduct portions of the Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services (EBAS) Exams. Provided Applicant is compliant with Tennessee Professional Assistance Program (TNPAP), the APRN application shall be granted, held in abeyance until payment, and upon issuance the APRN certificate and RN license shall be suspended, the suspensions stayed, and both credentials placed on probation concurrent with TNPAP monitoring for not less than three years, subject to terms and conditions including reporting requirements and a minimum of twelve months of APRN practice while under TNPAP monitoring. The multistate privilege will be deactivated until the license and certificate are unencumbered and applicant is eligible.
