


Suicide Deaths In Tennessee 2020-2023

About 56% of the 8,938 violent deaths in TN since 2020 were suicides







Circumstances Surrounding Death

- » 55% were identified as currently having a mental health problem
- » 16% had a history of prior suicide attempts
- » 26% indicated that problems with an intimate partner contributed to the incident
- » In 18% of incidents, an argument or conflict led to death
 - » In 60% of these cases, injury occurred within 24 hours of the argument

**166 (3.3%) decedents did not have sufficient available information to collect circumstances variables. Percentages are calculated using the 4,846 decedents with known circumstances. If a circumstance is not endorsed, this may indicate either that the circumstance is known not to have occurred OR that it is unknown whether the circumstance has occurred.

Among poisoning deaths:



- » 49% involved antidepressants
- » 26% involved prescription opioids
- » 30% involved benzodiazepines
