

Tennessee Tattoo Apprenticeship Completion Application

I attest that I have met the one-year Tattoo Apprenticeship required under T.C.A 62-38-204 and the following information is true and accurate:

T.C.A 62-38-204(g): To receive a tattoo artist license, a tattoo artist must be trained in the profession of tattooing, including sterilization methods, in a certified shop for at least one (1) year under a currently licensed tattoo artist who has been certified and operating in compliance with applicable laws in this state for no fewer than three (3) years, or who has been licensed in this state for fewer than three (3) years, but licensed in another state for ten (10) years or more. The tattoo artist must provide the tattoo artist's signature on this state's tattoo apprenticeship completion application signifying that the apprentice tattoo artist has met the requirement of this section.
