*l.e., infant was eaual to or greater than 23 weeks of gestation or greater than 500 grams at birth.

CHILD FATALITY | 2022

In 2022 there were 952 **CHILD DEATHS** in Tennessee. The Tennessee **Child Fatality** rate was 22.6% HIGHER than the national rate.



MEDICAL CONDITIONS REMAIN THE TOP CONTRIBUTOR.

51.9% of ALL CHILD DEATHS* 444/855

64.2% of INFANT **DEATHS** 296/461

EXTERNAL CAUSES of injury.



91.9% of deaths with an **EXTERNAL CAUSE** were deemed **PROBABLY** PREVENTABLE.



DROWNING was the **LEADING CAUSE of** death for 1-4 YEAR OLDS.



FIREARMS were the **LEADING EXTERNAL CAUSE** of death.



MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES were the **3RD LEADING CAUSE** of death.



Unintentional **POISONING DEATHS MORE** THAN DOUBLED from 2018-2022.



26.2% of INFANT DEATHS were from **SLEEP-RELATED** causes.



MORE THAN 2 OUT OF 5 OF ALL CHILD DEATHS WERE **PROBABLY** PREVENTABLE.
