2017-2022 Maternal Mortality Review Program Data



In Tennessee, between 2017 and 2022,

57 PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM WOMEN WERE VICTIMS OF HOMICIDE.



1 in 10 maternal deaths was a homicide



78% died by firearm



55% were killed by their partner or ex-partner



26% died while pregnant

A **maternal death** refers to the death of a woman during pregnancy or within one year following the end of pregnancy.

Contributing Factors in Maternal Homicide Deaths



- **▶** Limited prenatal care
- **▶** Lack of screening for intimate partner* violence
- **▶** Denial of intimate partner violence when screened
- ► Lack of access to victim resources
