## **Maternal Suicides in Tennessee**

2017-2022 Maternal Mortality Review Program Data



## IN TENNESSEE, BETWEEN 2017 AND 2022, **27 PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM WOMEN DIED BY SUICIDE**.



**85%** occurred between 42 days and 1 year postpartum



Almost **60%** were determined to be related to the pregnancy



Substance use disorder contributed in **48%** of cases

1 in 20 naternal deaths was a suicide

A **maternal death** refers to the death of a woman during pregnancy or within one year following the end of pregnancy.

## **Contributing Factors in Maternal Suicide Deaths**



- ▶ Unaddressed mental health and substance use issues, including the lack of screening, treatment, or referral to treatment for mental and behavioral health conditions
- ▶ Limited access to care and treatment for mental health conditions or substance use disorder
- ▶ Legal or child welfare system involvement
- ► Intimate partner\* violence
