

The composition of TBI registry patients in 2023 aligned closely with the overall demographics of Tennessee.

72% NON-HISPANIC WHITE

14% **NON-HISPANIC BLACK**

10% **NON-HISPANIC** OTHER/UNKNOWN

3% **HISPANIC***

★ TENNESSEE TBI TRENDS

Among TBI patients **45 YEARS** or **OLDER**, **MOST INJURIES** occurred due to UNINTENTIONAL **FALLS**

Among TBI patients 44 YEARS or YOUNGER, 6 **MOST INJURIES** occured due to **MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES**

TBIs caused by UNINTENTIONAL FALLS were ** MOST COMMON in **FEMALE PATIENTS** 65 YEARS or OLDER

The number of TBIs resulting from **MOTOR VEHICLE** CRASHES was THREE TIMES HIGHER IN MALE PATIENTS compared to female patients



MODERATELY SEVERE TBIs

HISPANIC patients had the **HIGHEST** number of **WORK-RELATED** INIURIES
