Women who selected the "other" write-in option were excluded from the analysis. Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) methods include Intrauterine Device (IUD) or contraceptive implant.

Long-Acting Reversible Contracteption (LARC) micross include bird control pills, shots or injections (e.g., Depo –Provera), contraceptive patch, and vaginal ring.

Least effective methods include condom, rhythm method/natural family planning, and withdrawal.

4.) Insurance: other state-specific government plans or programs such as SCHIP/CHIP are excluded from estimates. Those selecting "other" types were excluded.

"Private" includes private only, any other insurance in combination with private; TRICARE, or other military-type insurance.

"Medicaid" includes Medicaid or other state-named Medicaid program (e.g. TennCare).
"None" is defined as no selected insurance or selecting only Indian Health Service (IHS).
