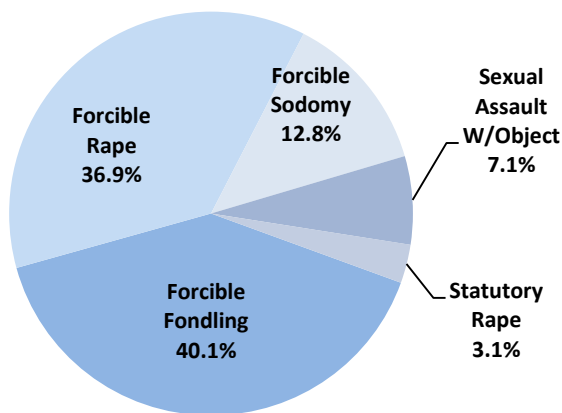

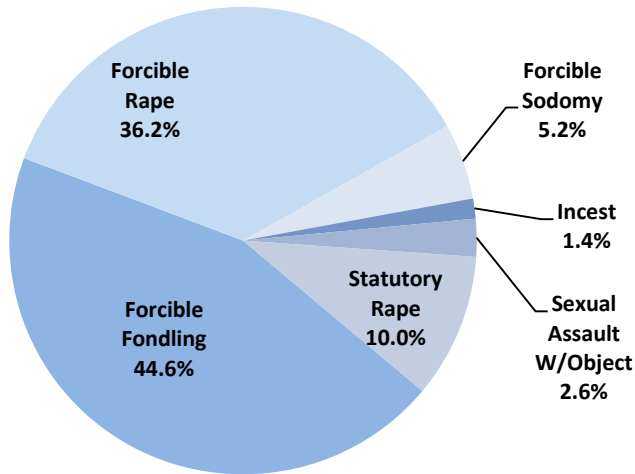

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

- 14-17 years olds had the highest rate of sexual assault compared to other age groups
- Females were approximately seven times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- The sexual assault rate was higher among blacks than whites, but this difference was not statistically significant
- Within the East Region, assault rates ranged from 15.4 in Scott County to 148.8 in Campbell County. The overall rate for the region was 103.1
- The most common types of sexual assault in the East Region were forcible fondling (44.6%) and forcible rape (36.2%)

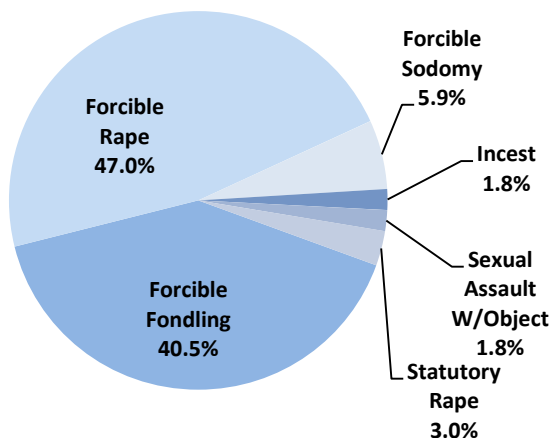

- 10-24 years olds had the highest rate of sexual assault compared to other age groups
- Females were approximately six times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- Blacks were more likely than whites to be sexually assaulted
- The most common types of sexual assault in Hamilton County were forcible rape (47.0%) and forcible fondling (40.5%)

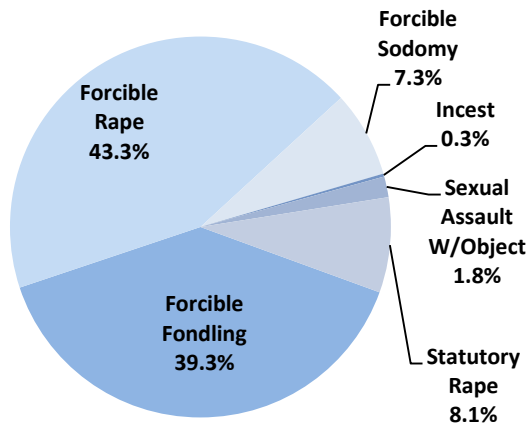

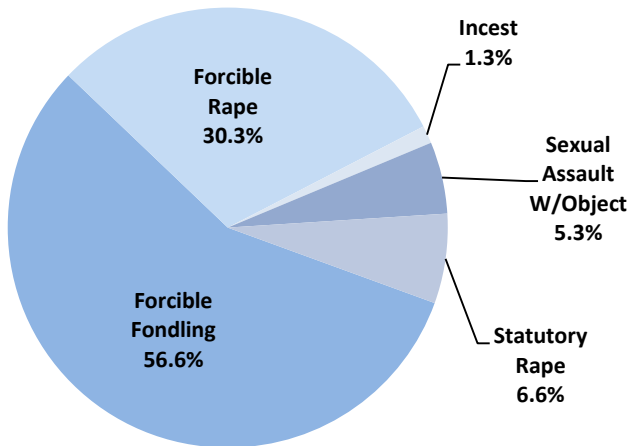

- Adolescents 10-17 years olds had the highest rate of sexual assault compared to other age groups
- Females were approximately six times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- The sexual assault rate was higher among blacks than whites, but this difference was not statistically significant
- The most common types of sexual assault in Madison County were forcible fondling (56.6%) and forcible rape (30.3%)

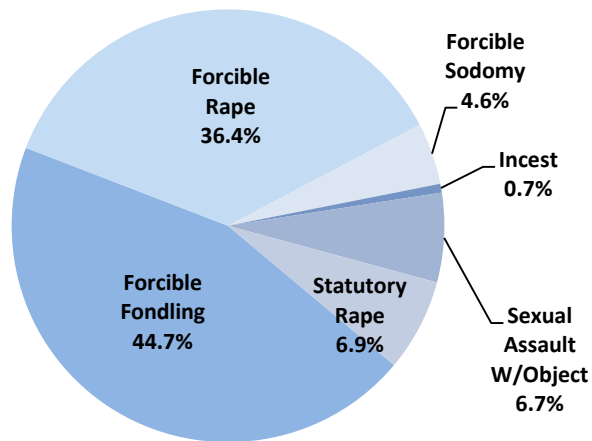

- 14-17 years olds had the highest rate of sexual assault compared to other age groups
- Females were approximately eight times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- The sexual assault rate was higher among blacks than whites, but this difference was not statistically significant

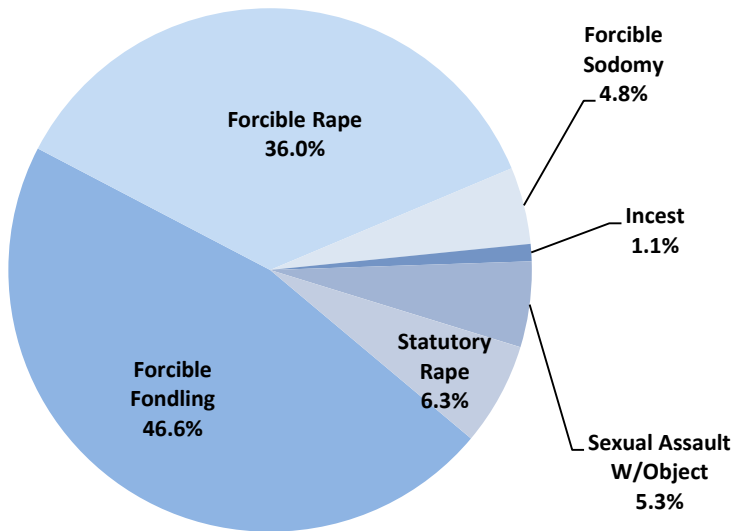

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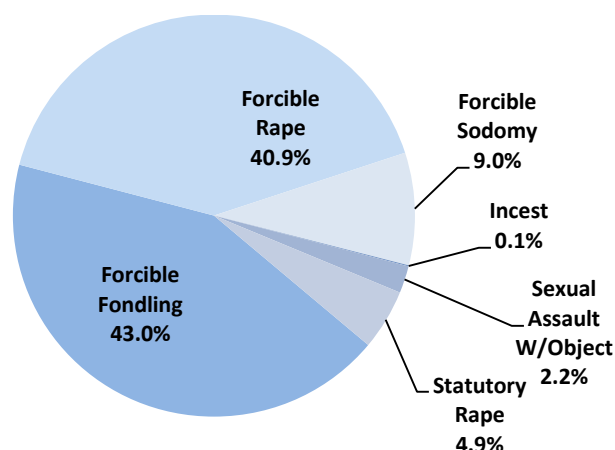

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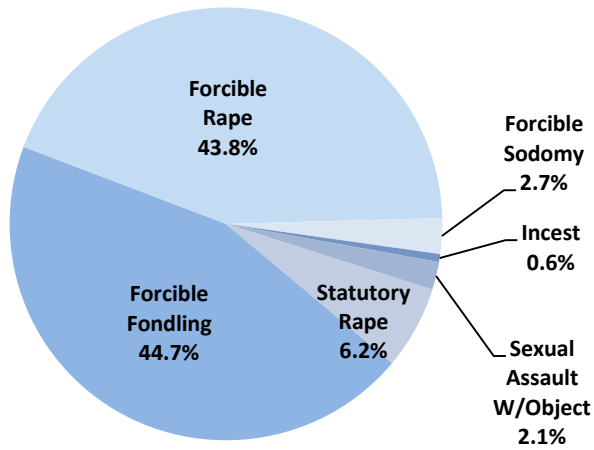

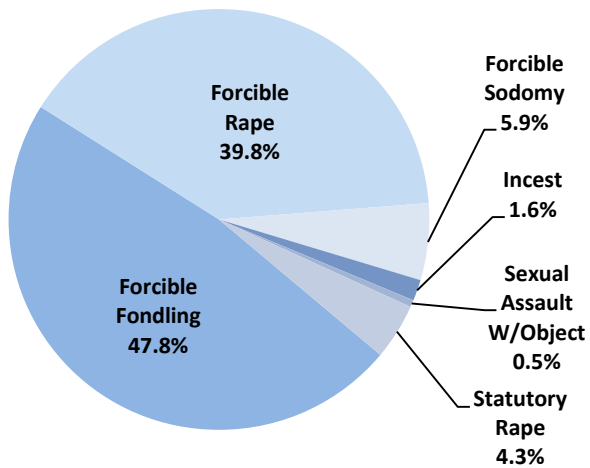

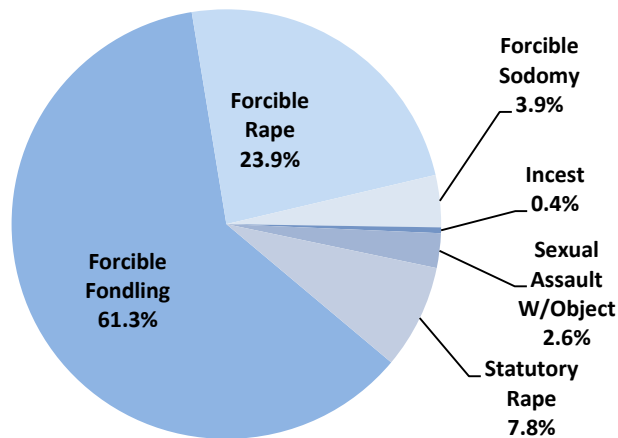

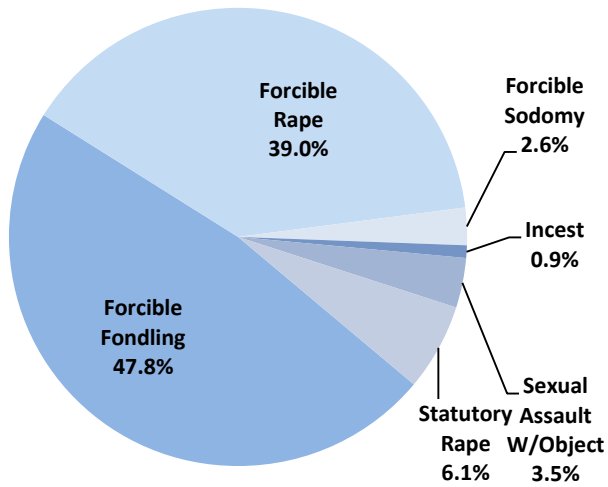

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

- 10-24 years olds had the highest rate of sexual assault compared to other age groups
- Females were approximately eight times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- The sexual assault rate was higher among whites than blacks, but this difference was not statistically significant
- Within the Upper-Cumberland Region, assault rates ranged from 0 in Van Buren County to 125.2 in Putnam County. The Overall rate for the region was 74.7
- The most common types of sexual assault in the Upper-Cumberland Region were forcible fondling (47.8%) and forcible rape (39.0%)

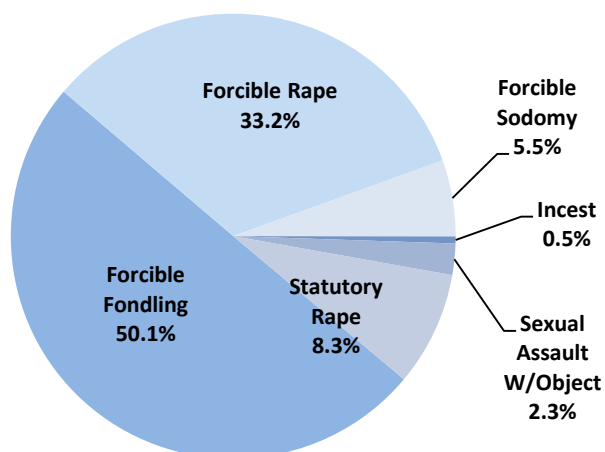

- Females were approximately seven times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- The sexual assault rate was higher among blacks than whites, but this difference was not statistically significant
- Within the West Region, assault rates ranged from 15.9 in Carroll County to 195.9 in Haywood County. The overall rate for the region was 86.6
- The most common types of sexual assault in the West Region were forcible fondling (50.1%) and forcible rape (33.2%)

Figure 1: Sexual Assault Victims in Tennessee by Year, 2014-2018[†]

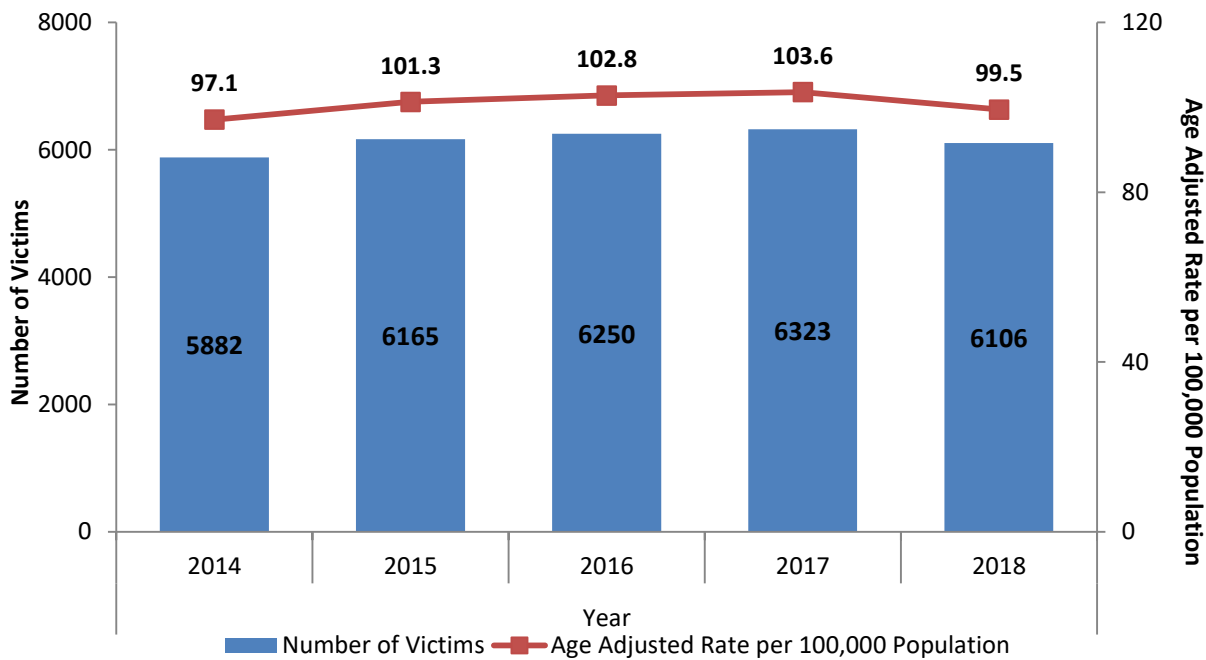
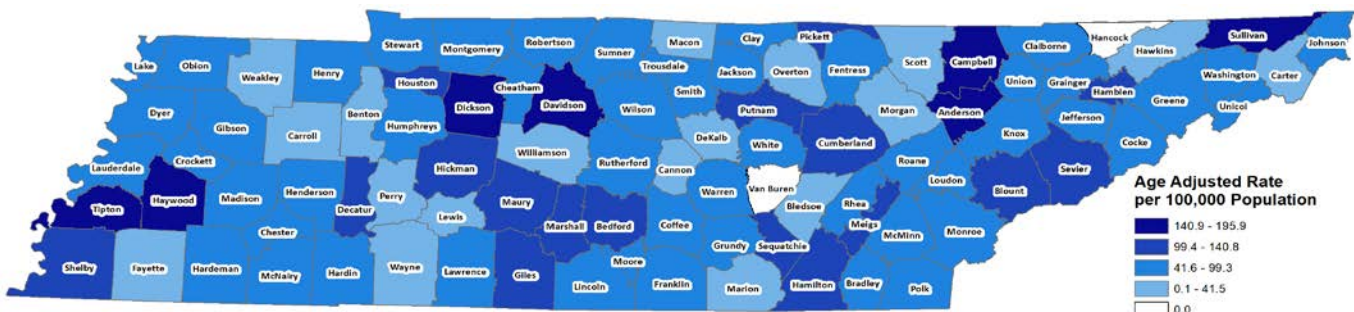
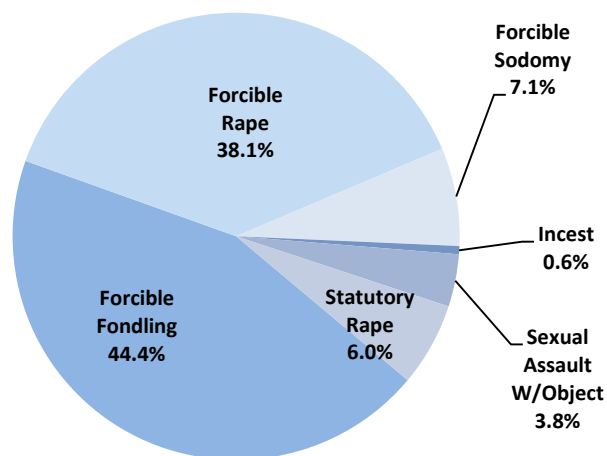


Figure 2: Sexual Assault Victims by County, 2018

- Between 2014 and 2018, the sexual assault rate in TN increased from 97.1 to 99.5
- 14-17 years olds had the highest rate of sexual assault compared to other age groups
- Females were approximately eight times as likely as males to be sexually assaulted
- Blacks were more likely than whites to be sexually assaulted
- Among Tennessee Health Department Regions, assault rates ranged from 63.5 in Northeast to 184.9 in Sullivan County. The overall rate for Tennessee was 99.5
- The most common types of sexual assault in Tennessee were forcible fondling (44.4%) and forcible rape (38.1%)
