Among TBI patients 44 YEARS or YOUNGER, MOST INJURIES occured due to MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES TBIs caused by UNINTENTIONAL FALLS were 脊脊脊 MOST COMMON in FEMALE PATIENTS 65 YEARS or OLDER

The number of TBIs resulting from MOTOR VEHICLE CRASHES was NEARLY DOUBLE (1.9 times) in MALE PATIENTS compared to female patients
