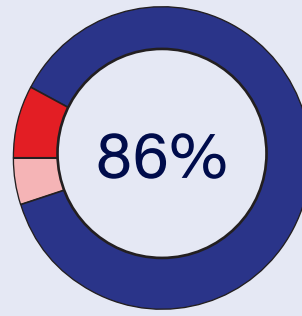




SUICIDE DEATHS IN TENNESSEE 2022

About **57%** of the 2,212 violent deaths in TN in 2022 were suicides

About four out of five (80%) suicide deaths were among males



Most suicide deaths were in the non-Hispanic white population

Method of Death



Among poisoning deaths:



- » 46% involved antidepressants
- » 28% involved prescription opioids
- » 27% involved benzodiazepines

Circumstances Surrounding Death

- » **58%** were identified as currently having a mental health problem
- » **15%** had a history of prior suicide attempts
- » **25%** indicated that problems with an intimate partner contributed to the incident
- » In **18%** of incidents, an argument or conflict led to death
 - » In **65%** of these cases, injury occurred within 24 hours of the argument

**35 (2.8%) decedents did not have sufficient available information to collect circumstances variables. Percentages are calculated using the 1,227 decedents with known circumstances. If a circumstance is not endorsed, this may indicate either that the circumstance is known not to have occurred OR that it is unknown whether the circumstance has occurred.
