RE: Inactive Status Extension Request – The Waters of Robertson, Springfield – NH #216

Dear Ms. Reed:

We hope this correspondence finds you well. On March 24, 2026, The Waters of Robertson, Springfield – NH #216 (“The Waters of Robertson”) received correspondence regarding the upcoming expiration of the facility’s inactive status (“Correspondence”). Pursuant to the Correspondence, if The Waters of Robertson wants to extend its inactive status, then it must submit a letter requesting an extension by April 2, 2026.

Please allow this letter to serve as The Waters of Robertson’s request to extend its inactive status for six (6) months. The Waters of Robertson is currently in inactive status. This facility needs to remain on inactive status as the Waters of Robertson remains in pending regulatory litigation with the Departmental Review Board with CMS. Moreover, as a result of the pending regulatory matter, the same conditions that warranted the granting of the inactive license as indicated in the original October 10, 2023 correspondence, and warranted the extension of inactive

status as described in the May 29, 2025 and October 23, 2025 correspondence, remain present. That is, the Waters of Robertson as licensee had a need to temporarily suspend operations and intends to continue operations for a period of suspension.

Nonetheless, as the Waters of Robertson has not placed its license back in an active status before the expiration of the current inactive timeframe it therefore requests that this present request for its extension of the inactive license be placed on the next Commission Agenda for review by the Health Facilities Commission.
