Dear Ms. Reed,

We would like to place Radiosurgical Center of Memphis, License 74 on inactive status.

We have come to this conclusion after studying the current financial environment. Currently, the maximum we can collect on a Medicare patient is about \$2,600. It currently cost the facility over \$10,000 to complete a case.

In the past there were sufficient commercial type cases to cover this shortfall. As time has gone on, the number of commercial cases we perform continues to decrease. It has come to a point where there is simply not enough of these cases to cover the Medicare reimbursement shortfall.

Compounding this problem the commercial insurance providers continue to contest almost every invoice we send. They often request information they have often received and continue to build paperwork barriers to our receiving payment. In addition, they have held back funds from cases far beyond stated contract terms.

We continue to believe Stereotactic Radiosurgery is a very valuable option for patients in our community. As such, we intend to use this time to explore our options with larger institutions. We believe they will be able to enjoy better economies of scale and they receive a much better reimbursement from Medicare. We anticipate this process should take no more than 9 months.

Our last patient was treated on February 25, 2026
