Subject: Extension Request for Inactive Status of Facility License - Douglas Post Acute and Rehabilitation Center

Dear Ms. Rutherford Reed,

I am writing to formally request an extension so that the facility license of Douglas Post Acute and Rehabilitation Center remains in an inactive status for an additional six (6) month period. We kindly ask that this matter be scheduled for discussion at the upcoming Health Facilities Commission Board meeting as our inactive status is set to expire on April 22, 2026.

As you may be aware, Douglas Post Acute and Rehabilitation Center received a Termination Notice from the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), which resulted in the closure of our facility.

The decision to terminate our Medicare provider agreement was made following a comprehensive review of our operations by CMS. While we have always been committed to providing high-quality healthcare services to our community, certain issues came to light that necessitated this drastic action by the state. We acknowledge these concerns and are continuously and actively working to address and rectify them, with the goal of re-establishing our operations in the future.

In light of this situation, we humbly request that our facility license remain in an inactive status as we work diligently to meet the necessary requirements and standards for re-certification and reopening. We understand the importance of complying with state regulations and are fully committed to rectifying the issues that led to our facility's closure.

By extending our facility license in an inactive status, it will allow us to focus on addressing the concerns raised by CMS while ensuring that we meet and exceed the standards set by the Health Facilities Commission.

We kindly ask for your support and understanding during this challenging period and hope for your assistance in facilitating the process of extending our facility license in an inactive status.
