
Please be advised that this firm represents Pruitt Healthcare-Nashville, LLC (“**Pruitt**”). On behalf of Pruitt, we respectfully request a further extension of the inactive status for license #47 for a period of twelve (12) months.

As you know, Pruitt was granted a Certificate of Need on March 26, 2025 (CN2409-026, the “**CON**”) and is now working to implement the CON by the construction of a new facility as proposed in the CON application. Pruitt also intends to seek abeyance of nursing home annual assessment fees under T.C.A. § 75-5-1006(f) while its license is inactive.
