The proposed service area includes the following eight ZIP Codes which are located in northern Hamilton County, as well as portions of Bledsoe, Rhea and Sequatchie Counties: 37379 – Soddy Daisy; 37373 – Sale Creek; 37343 – Hixson; 37321 – Dayton; 37327 – Dunlap; 37338 – Graysville; 37377 – Signal Mountain; and 37415 – Red Bank. The applicant is owned by Parkridge Medical Center, Inc. whose parent company is HCA Healthcare Inc.
