The new home health organization will be limited to the administration of home infusion and injection products to pharmacy patients of pharmacies which are subsidiaries of TwelveStone, Holdings, Inc. The proposed service area will include all 95 Tennessee counties, however only 92 of those counties are subject to Certificate of Need review. The applicant also plans to serve Grundy, Lake, and Perry Counties which are designated as economically distressed counties and are exempt from CON requirements. The applicant is owned by TwelveStone Holdings, Inc. The estimated project cost is \$134,416.</p> <p><b>CONDITION: Limited to the administration of home infusion and injection products to pharmacy patients of pharmacies which are subsidiaries of TwelveStone Holdings, Inc.</b></p>

Imaging services to be provided are MRI (adults and pediatrics), CT, X-ray and Ultrasound. The ODC will be located at 7326 Maynardville Pike, Knoxville (Knox County), TN 37938. The proposed service area includes Anderson, Knox, and Union Counties. The applicant is owned by University Diagnostics LLC with the following membership interests - University Health Systems, Inc. (72.5%); OIA of Knoxville, a wholly owned subsidiary of Outpatient Imaging Affiliates, LLC, (22.5%); and URAD, LLC, an affiliate of Association of University Radiologists, PC (5%). This project will be co-located with Karing Hearts Cardiology PC within a medical office building located at 701 North State of Franklin Road, Suite 9, Johnson City (Washington County), Tennessee 37604. The project will seek licensure from the Health Facilities Commission (HFC) as a single-specialty ambulatory surgical treatment center limited to cardiac device implantation and related procedures, and diagnostic cardiac catheterization. The proposed service area includes Carter, Greene, Johnson, Unicoi, and Washington Counties. The applicant is owned by Karing Hearts Cardiology Heart and Vascular Center, LLC. The proposed service area includes Shelby County. The applicant is owned by Metropolitan Ambulatory Surgery Center, LLC.
