Re: TriStar Fairview Freestanding ER Application


Executive Director Grant,

I believe that establishing a freestanding emergency room in Fairview will help residents in Williamson, Hickman, and Dickson counties access critical care more quickly during life-threatening emergencies.

Residents in the eastern portion of Dickson County can be more than 20 minutes from the nearest emergency room. An ER in Fairview would provide a much closer access point for those individuals and families. In situations involving stroke, cardiac arrest, serious accidents, or other medical crises, minutes matter. Improving proximity to emergency care is an important step in protecting the health and safety of our communities.
