Petitioner has proven to the satisfaction of this Commission that the conditions of the June 25, 2025, Consent Order have been met and termination of probation is appropriate. See Comp. Att. 1. The Order placed Petitioner’s license (ACLF Lic. No. 62) on probation for six (6) months, provide monthly reports to the Commission, and payment of civil monetary penalties totaling nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$9,500.00).




UNSWORN DECLARATION
