Adult and pediatric verifications are separate – they can be done at the same time but that is not always the case – I think they should be listed separately – for instance we are a verified adult burn unit – additionally we take care of pediatric patients – however – we are not a pediatric verified unit at the moment but will be when we go up for verification again in 3 years.

I agree with the ABLS requirements – it could be added that other burn providers such as therapy, pharmacy, program coordinators, etc are encouraged to become ABLS certified but are not required to be ABLS certified.

It also has occurred to me that we did not include the specific language in the document that describes the components necessary to become a pediatric verified burn center that language is only found in the pre-review questionnaire?

I just spoke with Dena at the American Burn Association, and she sent me over the below information.

Some Burn centers tend to have Criteria Deficiencies (CD) in one or more of the below for Pediatrics.

I added in red if they are listed as Criteria 1 or Criteria 2 deficiencies.

One Level 1 criterion deficiency will result in non-verification, anything higher than five or more Level 2 CD's will also result in non-verification.

It is always nice to chat with you. Please see information regarding pediatric burn centers below.

The ABA distinguishes the burn centers as Adult only, Adult and Pediatric and Pediatric only. An adult and pediatric burn center can be verified for both Adult and Pediatric or just Adult. The CDs listed below are ones I have documented and have been cited in both A & P and just P.

Section 2-

2.1-The burn center must have a sufficient volume of acute burn admissions on an ongoing

basis. (Criteria 1 deficiency)

2.3 -The burn center maintains and average daily census of 3 or more patients with acute burns. (Criteria 1 deficiency)

Section 3

3.12-The burn center director demonstrates CME or evidence of education in pediatric burn care annually (i.e. Pediatric Advanced Life Support, pediatric topic review, local regional meetings, invited speakers, journal clubs etc.) (Criteria 2 deficiency)

3.14-The burn center director is involved in at least 25 pediatric cases annually. (Criteria 2 deficiency)

Section 11-

11.3-Emergency physicians are board certified or eligible for certification by an appropriate emergency medicine board according to current requirements in pediatric emergency medicine. (Criteria 2 deficiency)

Section 12-

12.4-There are protocols for burn specific care in collaboration with the PICU. (Criteria 2 deficiency) 12.5 PICU works in concert with the Burn Center Director to develop protocols for intensive care. (Criteria 2 deficiency)

Section 13

13.4-For centers admitting patients under 2 years of age and requiring surgery, an anesthesiologist with certification in pediatric anesthesiology is available 24/7 (Criteria 2 deficiency)
13.5-A pediatric anesthesiology representative serves as a liaison to burn quality improvement program. (Criteria 2 deficiency)
