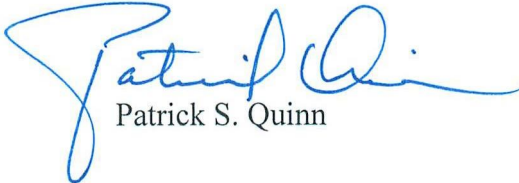
Dear Mr. McIntyre,
