PETITION TO RELOCATE REMAINS AND TERMINATE BURIAL GROUNDS

Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §46-4-101, Petitioner, Raven Marshall requests that this Court enter an order permitting your Petitioner to have human remains removed and relocated. Petitioner further requests that this Court enter an order terminating the use of, and all rights and easements to use, the property formerly utilized as the Priddy Family Cemetery located in Eads, Shelby County, Tennessee. In support of the Petition, the Petitioner would state as follows:

1. Petitioner is the owner of Lots 28 and 29 in the unrecorded subdivision known as Wind Chase Farms, which is more particularly described in the Warranty Deed recorded as Instrument No. 21156943 recorded in the Register's Office for Shelby County, Tennessee, and a copy of which is attached and marked as **EXHIBIT A** to this Petition. ("Property")

2. The cemetery contains the remains of five individuals: Almeda P. Little Davies, Robert Oran Williams, Freddie L. Gorum, Maria Ann Priddy and Z.A. Rudisill. After a diligent

search, Petitioner has identified four living relatives of Maria Ann Priddy together with name and contact information, who are Elizabeth Kerkstra, 520 Hagen Drive, Hendersonville, NC 28739, Jeffrey Bond, 73 Templar Place, Oakland, CA 94618, Nick Bond, and Carol Clear Reed. These individuals have been notified and have consented to the proposed action relating to the Priddy Family Cemetery. No other individuals by name and address have been identified as presently living who are heirs of the five individuals interred within the Priddy Family Cemetery.

3. Others who are unknown as relatives of the persons interred within the Priddy Family Cemetery may have rights which will be affected by the orders of this Court. Petitioner seeks publication of notice to these individuals pursuant to §§21-1-204 and 46-4-103(b).

4. An exact copy of this Petition is being served on the Tennessee Historical Commission in accordance with Tennessee Code Annotated §46-4-103.

5. Petitioner seeks permission from this Court to relocate the remains contained within the Priddy Family Cemetery and to close the cemetery, which is presently located in Eads, Shelby County, Tennessee. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court.

6. The Priddy Family Cemetery was a historical cemetery. It was an active family cemetery from 1859 until 1954. Robert O. Williams was the last person interred in the Priddy Family Cemetery according to the research of the Petitioner.

7. Since that time the Property has been sold by the W.B. Bryan family through several transfers to Wind Chase Farms, Inc. in 1998. At that time, the land encompassing the Priddy Family Cemetery was developed into a residential neighborhood containing lots greater than four acres in area. Each lot in the area, with the exception of the subject Property, has been developed into a residential property.

8. The condition of the Priddy Family Cemetery has become neglected and is unmaintained. Several of the grave markers have been broken and lay flat on the ground. There is no evidence that anyone has performed maintenance or upkeep at the cemetery for many years. Certain of the graves have become sunken and are in need of repair themselves.

9. The location of the five graves is contained within an area approximately 30 feet by 45 feet. It is located approximately 230 feet from Preakness Drive and 60 feet from the southern boundary of the Property. The location and configuration of the gravesites is shown on **EXHIBIT B**.

10. The genealogical research performed on behalf of the Petitioner showing the known heirs of Almeda P. Little Davies is attached and marked as **EXHIBIT C**. These are also the relatives of Robert Oran Williams and Freddie L. Gorum. No living relative of Almeda P. Little Davies, Robert Oran Williams or Freddie L. Gorum could be located.

11. The genealogical research performed on behalf of the Petitioner showing the known heirs of Mr. Z.A. Rudisill is attached and marked as **EXHIBIT D**. No living relative of Z.A. Rudisill could be located.

12. The genealogical research performed on behalf of the Petitioner showing the known heirs of Maria Ann Priddy is attached and marked as **EXHIBIT E**. The identified living relatives of Maria Ann Priddy by name and contact information, are Elizabeth Kerkstra, Carol Clear Reed, Nick Bond, and Jeffrey Bond.

13. Although alternatives to the development of the lot have been investigated, there is no present plan, which is feasible, which would allow the cemetery to remain undisturbed. Due to its neglected nature and the inconsistent uses of both the surrounding area as residences and the

future development of the lot containing the cemetery in to a residential use, relocation of the cemetery is necessary.

14. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §46-4-101, the Property is no longer suited as a burial ground and as resting place for the persons interred there.

15. All the known and identified relatives of the deceased persons buried there have consented to the planned move and closure of the cemetery. Their declaration are collective attached as **EXHIBIT F**.

16. Your Petitioner has developed definite and appropriate arrangements for the disinterment and relocation of the individuals buried in the Priddy Family Cemetery. The move will be overseen by the Peebles Funeral Home, a local funeral home to insure that all due respect and honor is given to the individuals buried during the disinterment and reinternment. The remains will be reinterred at The Reid Family Cemetery, a local private cemetery about 1 mile to the South of the present location of the Priddy Family Cemetery. A permanent marker will be affixed at or near the present location of the Priddy Family Cemetery indicating that the individuals have been moved.

17. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated §46-4-103, your Petitioner further requests that this Court terminate the use of the land as a cemetery, including all rights and easements thereto.

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED your Petitioner prays:

1. That notice be served on the interested parties by publication;
2. That notice be served on all individuals identified as having rights to access the Priddy Family Cemetery, unless formal notice has been waived;
3. That following publication a hearing be conducted;

4. For an order allowing your Petitioner to relocate the remains present in the Priddy Family Cemetery and the entry of an order terminating all rights and easements as to the use of the Property as a burial ground; and

5. That your Petitioner have any further and general relief to which she may be entitled.

1. I am over the age of 18;
2. I have been provided notice of the intent of the present owner of the land encompassing the Priddy Family Cemetery in Eads, Tennessee, to relocate the remains buried there.
3. It has been disclosed to me the Priddy Family Cemetery has fallen into disrepair and is not maintained. It is located within a residential subdivision. The present owner of the surrounding land intends to relocate the remains of the persons buried, the graves, and the markers contained within the Priddy Family Cemetery, to the Reid Cemetery in Eads, Tennessee, approximately 1 mile to the south, on George R. James Road. The Reid Cemetery is a maintained, community cemetery which is presently operating in Eads, Tennessee. Each of the markers in the Priddy Family Cemetery will be relocated into the Reid Cemetery, and reinstalled. At the present location of the Priddy Family Cemetery, the present owner of the surrounding land will locate a marker indicating its historical significance and identifying the location, as relocated, of the person's buried in the Priddy Family Cemetery.
4. I consent to the relocation of the remains of the individuals buried in the Priddy Family Cemetery, and the closure of the Priddy Family Cemetery.
5. I waive any other formal notice of the Petition to Relocate the Priddy Family Cemetery.
