Demolition Request Form

All requests must be made by the property owner and submitted at least **30 days** prior to the commencement of any proposed demolitions. Property owners must receive written approval before commencing any work. Please submit the requested materials electronically to <u>Nina.Scall@tn.gov</u>. Questions may be directed to Nina Scall at <u>Nina.Scall@tn.gov</u> or 615.770.1095. Additionally, any proposed projects involving earth-moving activities such as construction, demolition. grading, and borrow work must undergo an archaeological review. Please submit the requested materials to <u>TDOA.StatePrograms@tn.gov</u>. Division of Archaeology (DOA) staff will provide a determination within 15 business days. If you have specific questions or need additional information on the archaeological review, please contact: <u>Dan.Brock@tn.gov</u>.

Required Attachments:

- <u>Architectural Descriptions:</u> Identify each structure that will be affected by demolition. Include the age, construction type, architectural style, structural description, historic use, modern use, and any associated history and old photos.
- <u>Photos of Existing Conditions:</u> Please submit photos of each structure to be demolished. Photos should feature each elevation and any interesting architectural details. Each photo must be saved with a notation and numbered: "State, County, Tract Name, Structure Name, and Photo Number." For example, TN_Williamson County_Spivey Tract_Home_001.tif (or jpeg). Additionally, please include a Photo Log.
- <u>Photo Log:</u> Shows the photos together in one document and contains a short description below each photo for interpretation ease. For example: Description Spivey Tract, Home, South façade (left) and east elevation (right), camera facing north, northwest. Photo 1 of 5.
- <u>Map:</u> Illustrates the location of the structure within the landscape.
